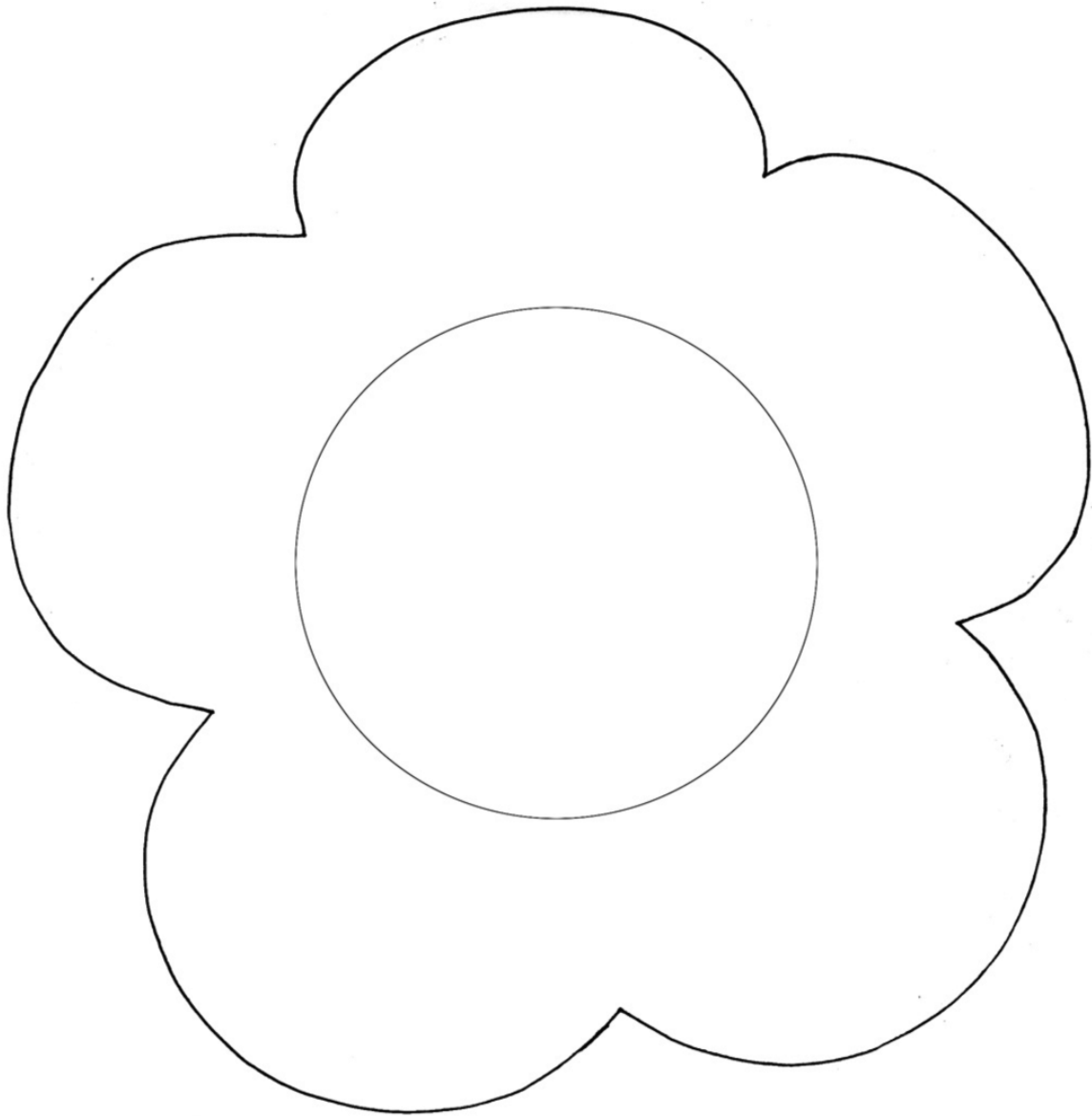


Activity sheet one

Response to Olaudah and Anna Maria's Story

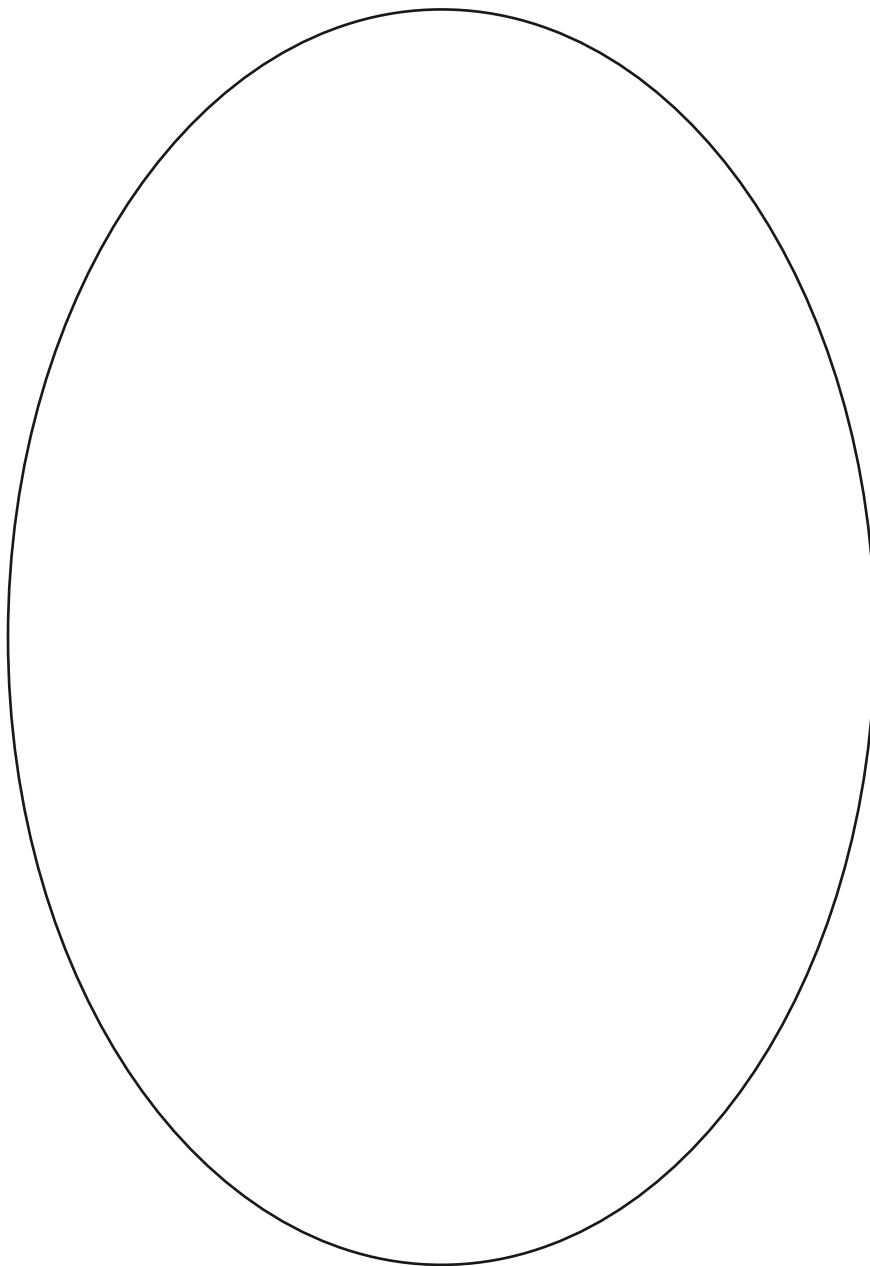
Write a word in each petal of the flower showing what the story of Olaudah and Anna Maria has made you think of, and/or decorate the flower to show how the story has made you feel.

Activity sheet five

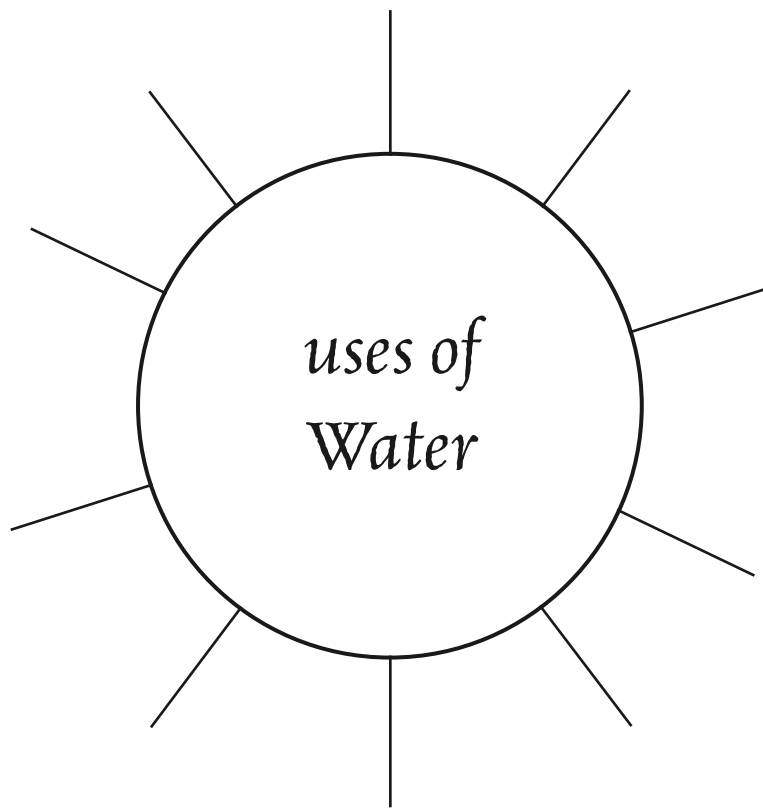
Memory Verses

Fill in chart with all the things we use water for – you can add some extra lines if you can think of more than 10. Underline or circle the things which are essential to life – leave out the things we don't really need.



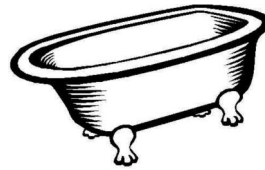
Activity sheet six (KS1)

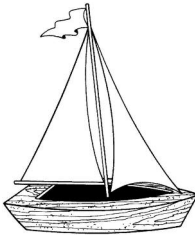

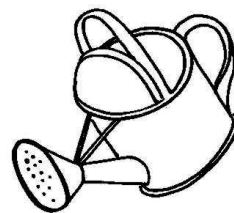
